

THE JENNIFER MOLYNEUX **SPEECH AWARD 2020**

Since 2007, a special annual award has been established for talented Speech competitors. This is to be used for further training and has been made possible by a generous bequest of the late Jennifer Molyneux who competed in the Bromley Festival for many years and later was a member of the Festival Committee and its Hon. Treasurer. She always considered that the Festival experience had contributed to her success in her career.

The Award is open to Speech competitors in the Festival who:

- (a) are aged 16 years or over in the current academic year; and
- (b) enter a Public Speaking class (D8 or D49) a sonnet class (D27) and at least one other acting solo class and attain Honours/Distinction marks.

For 2020 the value of the Award will be £250.

To apply, competitors should enclose with their official entry form, the application form opposite, and a Statement of not less than 500 words outlining their achievements and ambitions in the field of Speech and Drama, and indicating how they wish to use the Award, eg. for a holiday course, masterclass, or further tuition.

The Award will be presented at the Star Performer afternoon on Sunday 29 March 2020 at Bromley Parish Church, Church Road, Bromley. The winner will be invited to give a spoken introduction outlining his/her plans for the use of the Award, and to perform one of the items from their Festival programme.
